

RESOLUTION NO. 573

WHEREAS, the provision of a quality public education for the children and adults in the community is one of the highest responsibilities which the City government must meet; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria Public School System represents a substantial area of expenditure in the City's annual capital improvement budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is responsible for the City's financial planning process through its operation of the annual capital improvement budget and for the expenditure of City funds through monthly financial reports from the City Manager and through the annual independent audit report; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's responsibility for financial planning and control requires a higher level of reporting and a greater exchange of information than has been required in the past.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, requests that the Alexandria School Board submit to the City Council a quarterly report, which shall include but would not be limited to the following areas of interest:

1. Projected and actual cost
2. Projected and actual beginning and completion dates
3. Anticipated problems with proposed solutions

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT said quarterly reports will be submitted to the City Council no later than the 30th day of the month following the end of the quarter, beginning with the quarter ending September 30, 1977, or as soon thereafter as practicable.
