

RESOLUTION NO. 579


WHEREAS, in the interest of protecting the public health and welfare the Alexandria City Council desires to encourage a clean environment, and

WHEREAS, tobacco smoke is an irritant which pollutes the environment, and

WHEREAS, such pollution is particularly offensive to non-smokers in eating establishments,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Alexandria City Council requests restaurant owners in the City to set aside smoking and non-smoking areas on their premises wherever such an arrangement is possible.
