

RESOLUTION NO. 581

WHEREAS, on November 8, 1977 the voters of the Commonwealth of Virginia will decide if five proposals for bond funds should be approved; and

WHEREAS, approval of these proposals would enable the state to issue bonds to finance capital improvements for educational institutions, correctional facilities, mental health facilities, park and recreational facilities and port facilities for the citizens of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, these proposals are being presented as a means of meeting the demands of an increasing population and changing social conditions for the development of Virginia's public resources at a time when annual tax revenues are inadequate to finance the capital projects proposed; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Virginia counties, cities and towns that the five bond questions pass.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Alexandria City Council endorses the five State bond issues which are to be on the November 8, 1977 ballot and urges Alexandrians to support these bond questions in the upcoming election.
