

RESOLUTION NO. 587

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia on June 28, 1973 adopted a procedure for considering a cable television (CATV) ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the said City Council on September 12, 1973 adopted Resolution No. 240 establishing the Citizen's Advisory Committee on CATV and setting forth the functions and duties of the committee; and

WHEREAS, the committee has met and submitted reports on CATV for the City of Alexandria since its inception; and

WHEREAS, the city council has now determined that there does not appear to be sufficient interest in cable television in the city to justify a continuing committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY  
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That the Citizen's Advisory Committee on CATV be and hereby is dissolved.
2. That Resolution No. 240 adopted on September 12, 1973, for the purpose of establishing the committee be and hereby is repealed.
3. That all citizens who have served on the committee are commended for their contribution of time and talent to the city through service on the committee.
