

RESOLUTION NO. 594

WHEREAS, the 1977 General Assembly enacted Section 46.1-3.02 of the Code of Virginia which authorizes the adoption of local ordinances for the removal or immobilization of any motor vehicle parked on public streets and/or grounds when there are three or more outstanding, unpaid parking violations or otherwise unsettled parking violation notices; and

WHEREAS, said enabling legislation restricts this adoption of local ordinances only to counties which have adopted the county manager form of government; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria supported the above legislation during the 1977 General Assembly for general application throughout the Commonwealth, prior to the amendment which limited and restricted its application and denied it to the City of Alexandria.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia support the amending of Section 46.1-3.02 of the Code of Virginia to provide either for general application throughout the Commonwealth or to otherwise provide that the City of Alexandria be enabled to enact the necessary local ordinances to implement the provisions of this Section.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council requests the support of the City's delegation to the Virginia General Assembly in seeking this amendment to the Code of Virginia.
