

RESOLUTION NO. 614

WHEREAS, there now exists a serious problem with traffic using Lacy Boulevard in the Springdale neighborhood of Fairfax County and various streets in the Dowden Terrace neighborhood in the City of Alexandria, as a short-cut between Columbia Pike and Seminary Road, and

WHEREAS, the development of the Skyline Center and Northern Virginia Community College and other generators of motor vehicle trips encourage traffic to short-cut through the residential neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of both jurisdictions are concerned about the amount of traffic in their neighborhood, and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 1977, the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors endorsed a project to provide an alternate access between Columbia Pike and Seminary Road which would provide relief to the severe traffic impact presently suffered by the residents of the Springdale and Dowden Terrace neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 1978, the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors endorsed Alternative III of Three alternatives proposed by VDH&T, modified to provide a smooth transition into Moncure Avenue rather than intersecting with it at a 90° angle,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Alexandria City Council endorses Alternative III of the connection between Seminary Road and Columbia Pike as proposed by VDH&T and supported by the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council urges Fairfax County and the Virginia Department of Highways and Transportation to move expeditiously to begin construction of the connector road.
