

ORDINANCE NO. 128

AN ORDINANCE to regulate the operation of motor trucks and motor vehicle freight carriers in and through the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. That all motor trucks engaged in the transportation of freight entering the City of Alexandria, Virginia, from the south over State Highway No. 31, shall continue through the City of Alexandria, Virginia over the following route:

North on Patrick Street to Duke Street, west on Duke Street to Henry Street, north on Henry Street to Cameron Street, east on Cameron Street to Patrick Street, north on Patrick Street to Montgomery Street, west on Montgomery to Henry Street and thence north on Henry Street and over the overhead bridge over the right of way of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad and State Highway No. 31 to the city limits.

All such trucks entering the City from the north over State Highway No. 31 shall follow the same route southward through the city; provided, however, that the foregoing provisions shall not apply to trucks receiving or making deliveries in the City of Alexandria.

SECTION 2. No motor truck shall be operated over any street or highway in the City of Alexandria, weighing over 35,000 lbs. for the combined weight of the vehicle and contents.

SECTION 3. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding 90 days or both in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on the 10th day following its due publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
