

ORDINANCE NO. 130

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931, being "An Ordinance to regulate and restrict the location of buildings and structures and of premises to be used for trade, industry, residence or other specified uses within the City of Alexandria; to divide the City into zones, and to impose in each of said zones regulations designating the kinds or classes of trades, industries, residences or other purposes for which buildings or other structures or premises may be erected, altered or used; and to regulate the height, bulk and location of buildings and other structures and the areas of yards and open spaces, as amended."

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Zoning Map described and referred to in Section II of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25, 1931, as amended, be changed in the following particulars:

That all of the area of the east one-half of the square bounded by Henry, Montgomery, Patrick and Madison Streets, now classified "B" Residence Zone be changed to "E" Industrial Zone.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
