

## ORDINANCE NO. 133

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Ordinance No. 37 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, being an ordinance entitled "An ordinance to define ardent spirits and to prohibit the manufacture, use, sale, offering for sale, transportation, keeping for sale, and giving away of ardent spirits, etc." Approved the 2nd day of April, 1925.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 37 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, entitled "An ordinance to define ardent spirits and to prohibit the manufacture, use, sale, offering for sale, transportation, keeping for sale, and giving away of ardent spirits, etc," approved April 2nd, 1925, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
