

ORDINANCE NO. 134

AN ORDINANCE to Repeal and Re-enact Section 1 of Ordinance No. 20, of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, entitled "An Ordinance to prohibit profane swearing and drunkenness, how punished," approved December 20th, 1923.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia: Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 20 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved December 20th, 1923, be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

"Section 1. If any person having arrived at the age of discretion, profanely curse, swear or appear in any public place under the influence of intoxicants, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof be fined not less than Five nor more than One Hundred Dollars."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on the day following its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
