

ORDINANCE NO. 140

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, being an ordinance entitled "An ordinance to regulate and restrict the location of buildings and structures and of premises to be used for trade, industry, residence or other specified uses within the City of Alexandria, etc.," approved July 25th, 1931.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Zoning Map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

That all of the area of that lot of ground located at the southeast intersection of Peyton and Clyde Avenues, with a frontage of 50 feet on Peyton Avenue and a depth along Clyde Avenue, and for said width of fifty feet, of 100 feet, be changed from "A" Residence zone to "D" Commercial zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
