

ORDINANCE NO. 152

An Ordinance to Prohibit the Keeping of Poultry or Other Fowl in the Congested Area of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria Virginia:

Section 1.—That it shall be unlawful to keep poultry or other fowl in the congested area of the City of Alexandria, which area is hereby defined and bounded as follows:

On the North by Wythe Street, on the West by West Street from Wythe to Duke Street and by Henry Street from Duke Street to Wolfe Street; on the South by Duke Street from West to Henry Street and by Wolfe Street from Henry Street to the Potomac River; and on the East by the Potomac River.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to poultry or fowl kept in crates or coops at duly licensed stores for sale.

Section 2.—Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not exceeding Fifty Dollars.

Section 3.—This ordinance shall take effect on the 10th day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
