

ORDINANCE No. 161

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25, 1931, being an ordinance entitled "An ordinance to regulate and restrict the location of buildings and structures and of premises to be used for trade, industry, residence and other specified uses within the City of Alexandria; etc.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Zoning Map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, as amended, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

(a) That the area of that lot of ground located on the south side of Oronoco Street known as 514 Oronoco Street, having a frontage on Oronoco Street of 15 feet and a depth of 96 feet 7 inches, and the west line of which lot is 105 feet east of the east line of St. Asaph Street, be changed from "A" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

(b) That the area of that lot of ground located at the southwest corner of Patrick and Madison Streets, with a frontage on Patrick Street of 33 feet 2 inches, and a depth westwardly along Madison Street of 110 feet, be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
