

ORDINANCE No. 165

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, entitled "An Ordinance to regulate and restrict the location of buildings and structures and of premises to be used for trade, industry, residence or other specified uses within the city of Alexandria, etc.:" as amended.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Zoning Map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25, 1931, as amended, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

That the area of those lots of ground fronting on the east and west sides of DeWitt Avenue eastward from Lloyds Lane (formerly Bellefonte Avenue) for a distance of two blocks to the north side of Lloyd Avenue be changed from "B" Residence to "C" Residence Zone.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
