

ORDINANCE No. 167

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931, being an ordinance entitled "An ordinance to regulate and restrict the location of buildings and structures and of premises to be used for trade, industry, residence and other specified uses within the City of Alexandria, etc.," as amended.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Zoning Map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, as amended, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

(a) That the area of that lot of ground located at the northeast corner of Franklin and Patrick Streets with a frontage on Franklin Street of 127 feet and on Patrick Street of 86 feet, be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

(b) That the area of that lot of ground located on the west side of Patrick Street known and designated at 624 North Patrick Street, be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
