

ORDINANCE NO. 173

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25, 1931, being an ordinance entitled "An ordinance to regulate and restrict the location of buildings, and structures and of premises to be used for trade, industry, residence or other specified uses within the City of Alexandria, etc.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Zoning Map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, as amended, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

(a) That the area of that lot of ground located at the southwest intersection of Pitt and Princess Streets, belonging to the Alexandria Dairy Products Company, Inc., be changed from "C" Residence to "E" Industrial Zone;

(b) That the area of that lot of ground located at the southeast intersection of Pitt and Princess Streets belonging to A. J. Butcher be changed from "C" Residence to "E" Industrial Zone.

(c) That the area of that lot of ground known as No. 624 North Patrick Street, located on the west side of said street, be changed from "D" Commercial to "B" Residence Zone, as originally classified.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
