

ORDINANCE NO. 174

An Ordinance to provide the terms of reconstruction of concrete sidewalks to fit authorized curb grades.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That when in the construction of new curbs and gutters under the provisions of Ordinance No. 148, and in accordance with grades established by the City Engineer, as authorized by Ordinance No. 155, the grade of the curb does not accord with a concrete sidewalk previously constructed, and the owner of property facing the said curb requests the said walk to be reconstructed to agree with the curb grade, the City will reconstruct the said sidewalk, provided, the said walk was originally constructed on a grade authorized by the Board of Supervisors of Arlington County, or by the Council of the Town of Potomac, or by authority of the Council of the City and under the supervision of the surveyor or engineer employed by the said Board of Supervisors or Councils to give the said grade, and, provided that the said property owner pays into the City Treasury such proportionate amount of the total cost as may be determined in each instance by a Committee of three to be composed of the City Manager and two members of the Council to be appointed by the Mayor, such amount not to be less than one-third nor more than two-thirds of the total cost.

The said Committee shall also have authority to decide the conditions under which the original sidewalk was constructed and the advisability of reconstruction.

Section 2. The property owner shall have the privilege of time payments as specified in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 151.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
