

ORDINANCE No. 177

An **ORDINANCE** to amend Section 66 of Ordinance No. 170 of the City of Alexandria, approved January 17, 1935, entitled: "An Ordinance imposing taxes on licenses for municipal purposes for the year commencing January 1, 1935, and for each year thereafter, as amended."

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That Section 66 of Ordinance No. 170 of the City of Alexandria be repealed and re-enacted as follows:

"Section 66. **Loan Agents.** Any person, firm or corporation engaged in lending money on automobiles, household goods and chattels, sewing machines, wages or salaries, or on personal endorsements, upon which more than 6% per annum is charged, shall pay an annual license tax of \$300.00."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
