

## ORDINANCE NO. 178

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25, 1931, being an ordinance entitled "An ordinance to regulate and restrict the location of buildings and structures and of premises to be used for trade, industry, residence or other specified uses within the City of Alexandria, etc.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Zoning Map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25, 1931, as amended, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

- (A) That the area of premises 814 Franklin Street, with a frontage of approximately 75 feet on Franklin Street, be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.
- (B) That the area of that parcel of land belonging to Lula M. Deavers located on the south side of Washington Avenue, designated as Lot 7, Block 7, of Assessment Map 204, be changed from "A" Residence to "B" Residence Zone.
- (C) That the area of that lot of ground located at the southeast corner of Washington and Pendleton Streets, fronting on the east side of Washington Street 234 feet and on the south side of Pendleton Street 123 feet 5 inches, Assessment Map 140-4-1, belonging to John Loughran be changed from "A" residence to "C" residence zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
