

ORDINANCE NO. 179

An Ordinance to amend Section 25 of Ordinance No. 172 of the City of Alexandria, approved February 5th, 1935, entitled "An Ordinance to regulate traffic on the Streets and highways of the City of Alexandria, Virginia."

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 1. That Section 25 of Ordinance No. 172 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved February 5, 1935, be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

"Section 25. There is hereby created a Traffic Board to be composed of the Mayor, City Manager, and Chief of Police, which Board shall have power to prescribe the following regulations:

(a) Speed and weight of vehicles over bridges, causeways or viaducts in the City.

(b) Time limits on parking in areas where traffic conditions may require.

(c) No parking area.

(d) Traffic stops at intersections.

Any regulation adopted by the Traffic Board shall not be effective until the restriction imposed is clearly indicated on a sign or other marker or device erected at the area affected. Any regulation of the Traffic Board may, upon motion of a member of the Council, be amended or rescinded by a majority vote of the Council.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
