

ORDINANCE No. 180

An Ordinance to amend ordinance No. 172 of the City of Alexandria, Approved February 5, 1935, entitled "an ordinance to regulate traffic on the streets and highways of the City of Alexandria, Virginia."

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 1. That Section 27 of Ordinance No. 172 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved February 5, 1935, be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

"Section 27. Any violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance for which no other penalty is specifically provided herein, shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Five or more than Three Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not exceeding ninety days, or both, in the discretion of the court. Any violation of any effective regulation of the Traffic Board shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Two Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars for each separate offense and the Court may, in its discretion, for violations of Traffic Board regulations, suspend the payment of costs."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
