

ORDINANCE NO. 187

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the zoning map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, as amended, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

That the area of that lot of ground located at the southeast corner of Washington and Princess Streets, having a frontage of 72 feet 2 inches on Washington Street and the depth of 123 feet 5 inches eastwardly along Princess Street, be changed from "A" residence to "C" residence zone.

That the area of that lot of ground located at the northeast intersection of Washington and Gibbon Streets, commonly referred to as the Paff Shoe Factory property, be changed from "A" residence zone to "E" industrial zone.

That the area of that lot of ground known as lot 17, Block 2, Section 1 Rosemont be changed from "A" residence to "C" residence zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
