

## ORDINANCE NO. 191

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 1. That the zoning map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, as amended, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

That the area of premises 524 South Pitt Street be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial zone.

That the area of that lot of ground at the northwest corner of Montgomery Street and Washington Street, extended, binding on the north side of Montgomery Street 154 feet and on Washington Street, extended 100 feet, be changed from "A" Residence to "D" Commercial zone.

That the area of that lot of ground located on the west side of Patrick Street between Wilkes and Gibbon Streets, designated as Lot 4, Block 3 on 1930 Assessment Map 177, be changed from "B" Residence to "E" Industrial zone.

That the area of those lots located on the west side of Washington Street between Wythe and Montgomery Streets, designated as Lots 10 and 12, Block 16, on 1930 Assessment Map 133, be changed from "A" Residence to "C" Residence zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
