

**ORDINANCE NO. 192**

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 21 of Ordinance No. 172, entitled "An Ordinance to regulate traffic on the streets and highways of the City of Alexandria, Virginia."**

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That Section 21 of Ordinance No. 172 of the City of Alexandria, approved February 5, 1935 be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

**"Section 21." PARKING.**

(a) No person shall park a vehicle or permit it to stand whether attended or unattended, upon a street or highway in front of a private driveway, or within fifteen feet in either direction of a fire hydrant or the entrance to a fire station nor within twenty-five feet from the intersection of curb lines, or if none, then within fifteen feet of the intersection of property lines at an intersection of streets or highways.

(b) Double parking is prohibited on any streets or highways of the City, and for the purposes of this ordinance, parking a vehicle at such distances from the curb as to allow space for another vehicle between it and the curb shall be deemed double parking.

(c) Parking of trucks or commercial vehicles in residential districts for more than one hour is prohibited.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
