

## ORDINANCE NO. 194

### AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 109 OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, APPROVED JULY 25th, 1931.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. That the zoning map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, as amended, be changed and amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

- (a). That the area of premises known as No. 315 North Patrick Street be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial zone.
- (b). That the area of that lot of ground located on Slaters Lane, designated as Lot 1 Block 2 on 1930 Assessment Map 144 be changed from "A" Residence to "E" Industrial zone.
- (c). That the area of that lot described:

BEGINNING at the keystone and center line of the south arch of the bridge of the Washington-Alexandria Road spanning Four Mile Run and running thence through the bay or basin of Four Mile Run in a westerly direction with the boundary line between the City of Alexandria and County of Arlington as the same is now or may hereafter be monumented to the east line of the right of way of the Washington-Virginia Railway Company; thence in a southerly or southwesterly direction with the said right of way to its intersection with the southerly edge of Four Mile Run or basin; and thence easterly and northeasterly along the edge of said bay or basin mean high water line to the point of beginning. The area is more particularly shown upon a plat of Charles Alexander's estate made by George E. Garrett, Civil Engineer, December, 1924.

- be changed from "A" Residence to "E" Industrial zone.
- (d). That the area of that square of ground bounded by Pendleton, Wythe, Saint Asaph, and Washington Streets be changed from "A" Residence to "C" Residence zone.
- (e). That the area of that tract of ground containing 7.998 acres located on the east side of Washington Street, extended, and belonging to Robert Portner Brewing Company be changed from "A" Residence to "C" Residence zone.
- (f). That the area of premises designated as 515-517 Gibbon Street be changed from "C" Residence to "D" Commercial zone.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
