

ORDINANCE NO. 40.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Richmond, Fredericksburg & Potomac Railroad Company to construct and maintain a switch or siding from its track on Washington Street Extended into the property of Janney Brothers, Incorporated, between Columbus Street and Montgomery Street.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Richmond, Fredericksburg & Potomac Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, be and it is hereby authorized to construct and maintain a side track or switch from its existing track on Washington Street extended into the property belonging to Janney Brothers, Incorporated, the point of said switch to be seventy-seven feet south of the south side of Columbus Street and to extend in a southerly direction across the sidewalk and into the property now belonging to Janney Brothers, Incorporated, as shown on the blue print attached to and made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force from its passage.
