

ORDINANCE NO. 42.

AN ORDINANCE amending and reenacting an Ordinance approved May 7, 1925, and numbered 39; and also providing that at this time the Washington-Virginia Railway Company be required to grade and pave the space between its rails and two feet on each side thereof on Cameron Street from the west side of Columbus Street to the east side of West Street with a bituminous pavement on a gravel base and establishing the grade and line of said rail.

Whereas, the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia, has determined to have Cameron Street from the west side of Columbus Street to the east side of West Street graded and paved; and

Whereas, the tracks and rails of the Washington-Virginia Railway Company occupy a portion of the said street as above described; therefore,

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That for present purposes the said Washington-Virginia Railway Company is hereby directed and required, within thirty (30) days after the passage of this Ordinance, to grade and pave the space between its rails and two feet on each side thereof on Cameron Street from the west side of Columbus Street to the east side of West Street with a bituminous pavement on a gravel base; said bituminous pavement not to be less than three inches in thickness; all of said work to be done under the supervision of the City Manager and the City Engineer; and the grade and line of said rails shall conform to those that may be established by the City Manager or the City Engineer.

Section 2. All Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
