

ORDINANCE NO. 44.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Standard Oil Company, a corporation of the State of New Jersey, to construct, operate and maintain a side track in the beds of Union and Gibbon Streets which shall extend from the present side track as now constructed in the bed of Union Street and running into the property of the said Standard Oil Company at the southwest corner of Union and Gibbon Streets, the said side track to begin in the bed of Union Street approximately forty-two feet north of Gibbon Street and to extend in a southwesterly direction in the bed of Union Street and across the bed of Gibbon Street approximately one hundred and twelve feet to the property of the said Standard Oil Company.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA:

SECTION 1. That the Standard Oil Company, a corporation of the State of New Jersey be and it is hereby authorized to construct, operate and maintain a side track in the beds of Union and Gibbon Streets which shall extend from the present side track as now constructed in the bed of Union Street and running into the property of the said Standard Oil Company at the southwest corner of Union and Gibbon Streets, the said track to begin in the bed of Union Street approximately forty-two feet north of Gibbon Street and to extend in a southwesterly direction in the bed of Union Street and across the bed of Gibbon Street approximately one hundred and twelve feet to the property of the Standard Oil Company, the said side track being outlined in red on the plat hereto attached and made a part hereof, the said plat being designated "Southern Railway System. Lines East. Alexandria, Va. Track changes for Standard Oil Company of New Jersey. Scale 1" 20' May 12, 1925."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force from its passage.
