

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF CORPORATION ATTORNEY AND CREATING THE OFFICE OF CITY ATTORNEY, PROVIDING FOR HIS ELECTION, COMPENSATION AND QUALIFICATION, AND DEFINING HIS DUTIES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. That the office of Attorney for the Corporation as provided by the charter of the City Council of Alexandria be and it is hereby abolished, and in its place and stead the office of City Attorney is hereby created.

SECTION 2. The said City Attorney shall be elected by the City Council and shall hold office during the pleasure of the Council, at such compensation as the said Council may determine, but no person shall be chosen City Attorney unless he be a competent attorney at law and has been licensed to practice in all of the Courts of the Commonwealth of Virginia; and he shall have such duties and powers as may be conferred upon him by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, or the resolutions and ordinances of the Council of Alexandria, Virginia.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and this ordinance shall be effective from date of passage.
