

ORDINANCE NO. 56

An Ordinance to Regulate the Operation of Vehicles on the Streets; to Govern and Protect Pedestrians While Using Such Streets; to Provide Penalties for Violating the Provisions of this Ordinance; and to Repeal All Ordinances or Parts Thereof Inconsistent with the Provisions of this Ordinance.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of Alexandria:

Section 1.—That insofar as applicable to local conditions and except as herein provided the provisions of Chapter 474 of the Acts of Assembly of Virginia for 1926 be and they are hereby made and adopted as the law of the City of Alexandria to the same effect as if the said provisions were set forth herein verbatim, provided that the fines imposed for violations of this ordinance shall be turned over to the City Treasurer of Alexandria for the credit of the City Council of Alexandria instead of the State of Virginia.

Section 2.—All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective from passage.
