

## ORDINANCE NO. 58

### An Ordinance Providing For The Construction of Public Sewers and to Regulate the Use Thereof.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Va.:

Section 1.—That all public sewers shall be constructed by and at the cost of the City Council of Alexandria, and the City Council shall lay proper connection to the curb line whenever any property owner desires to make connection to any sewer now built or that may hereafter be built.

Section 2.—Any person, firm or corporation desiring to tap any public sewer by direct connection or by indirect connection through any private sewer of some other person leading into the public sewer shall before so doing apply to the City Engineer for permission to make connection and the City Engineer, upon such application shall by and with the approval of the City Council issue permit for such connection when such person shall have paid in to the City Treasury in cash or in any other manner satisfactory to City Council the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for each front foot of the lot upon which the house or houses are situated, and Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) additional for each connection from the sewer to the curb line of, or in the alley adjoining any house or lot.

Section 3.—It shall be unlawful for any person to fill up or in any manner injure or obstruct any public sewer, man-holes, or catch basins.

Section 4.—Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) or more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) at the discretion of the court.

Section 5.—All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6.—This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
