

## ORDINANCE NO. 59

An ordinance to amend and re-enact section III (A), (B), and (C) of ordinance No. 53, approved May 13th, 1926, and entitled "An ordinance making provision for the imposing and collecting of taxes on persons and property, real, personal and mixed, within the city of Alexandria, Virginia, for the fiscal year ending May 31, 1927, for the support of the city government, the payment of interest and principal on the city debt, the fixing of the compensation of the city manager, and for other municipal expenses: and appropriating to the several funds the several amounts required to defray the expenditures and liabilities of the corporation for the fiscal year ending May 31, 1927."

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, That Section III (A), (B), and (C) of Ordinance No. 53 be amended and re-enacted as follows:

Section III. (A) The revenue from the fifty cents (\$0.50) capitation tax provided for in Section II (A) shall be due and payable to the City Collector without discount, on or before October 15, 1926.

(B). The revenue from the Two Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$2.25) levy, provided for in Section II (B) shall be due and payable to the City Collector, without discount, on or before October 15, 1926. All bills not paid on or before October 15, 1926, shall be considered delinquent, and there shall be assessed and collected upon said bills a penalty of five per centum (5 per cent.) and upon all bills remaining unpaid on June 1, 1927, additional damage at the rate of six per centum (6 per cent.) per annum shall be assessed and collected.

The revenue from the additional twenty-five cents (\$0.25) levy provided for in Section II (B) shall be paid to the City Treasurer without discount, on or before December 1, 1926. All bills not paid on or before December 1, 1926, shall be considered delinquent, and there shall be assessed and collected upon said bills a penalty of five per centum (5 per cent.) and upon all bills remaining unpaid June 1, 1927, additional damages at the rate of six per centum (6 per cent.) per annum shall be assessed and collected. The assessment of rent charges and ground rents, in fee simple, shall be value at sixteen (16) times their annual amount.

(C) The revenue from the tax levied on bank stock as provided for in Section II (C) shall be due and payable to the City Collector, without discount, on or before October 15, 1926. All bills not paid on or before October 15, 1926, shall be considered delinquent and there shall be assessed and collected upon said bills a penalty of five per centum (5 per cent.) and upon all bills remaining unpaid on June 1, 1927, additional damages at the rate of six per centum (6 per cent.) per annum shall be assessed and collected.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately on its passage.
