

ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE DISPLAY OF MERCHANDISE,
WARES, FOODSTUFFS, ETC., ON THE SIDEWALKS OF THE CITY
OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria,
Virginia:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation shall place any goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuffs, etc., on or in any way obstruct the sidewalk or walkways of the city of Alexandria or occupy or use any of said sidewalks or walkways for the display or sale of said goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuff, etc., unless said person, firm or corporation shall be receiving or delivering the same and in no case shall such goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuff, etc., be allowed to remain on the sidewalk or walkway longer than is reasonably necessary for the delivery of same, provided, however, that this restriction shall not apply to King Street and such other locations as designed by the City Council, and provided that in no case where permitted or designed shall the sidewalk be obstructed for a space of more than thirty (30) inches beyond the building line and with the express provision that such display must be at least eighteen (18) inches above the sidewalk and in the case of foodstuffs must meet the requirements of the State health laws.

Section 2. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to prohibit the use of the sidewalks or walkways for construction purposes as provided in the building laws of the City of Alexandria.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be liable to a fine of not less than Five nor more than Fifty Dollars, for each offense, in the discretion of the court, and each day that the sidewalk or walkway shall be used or occupied in violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
