

ORDINANCE NO. 66

An Ordinance to Amend and Re-Enact Sections 1 and 6 of an Ordinance, No. 54, Entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Rates for Gas Manufactured by the City of Alexandria Gas Plant and Providing for the Collection Thereof."

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1.—Rate. The gross charge for gas shall be One Dollar and Seventy-Five Cents (\$1.75) for each one thousand (1,000) cubic feet for the first ten thousand (10,000) cubic feet consumed and One Dollar and Sixty-Five Cents (\$1.65) for the next ten thousand (10,000) cubic feet consumed and One Dollar and Fifty-Five Cents (\$1.55) for each one thousand (1,000) cubic feet over and above twenty thousand (20,000) cubic feet. All bills for gas consumed will be payable monthly and a discount of Thirty Cents (\$0.30) on each one thousand (1,000) cubic feet will be allowed provided payment is made within ten days from the date of the bill. All bills are subject to the minimum rate established by this ordinance. Bills shall be payable at the office of the City Collector.

Section VI. This ordinance shall take effect August 1, 1927.
