

ORDINANCE NO. 68

An Ordinance authorizing and empowering the Virginia Public Service Corporation, the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company, the Western Union Telegraph Company, and the Washington-Virginia Railway Company, to remove such poles and wires as belong to said companies as are now located or erected on King Street, from Harvard to Patrick Street, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and to replace the wires belonging to them now located on poles on King Street on the poles erected by the Virginia Public Service Corporation, with the consent of the said Virginia Public Service Corporation, and regulating the use or sale of such poles.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Virginia Public Service Corporation, the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company, the Western Union Telegraph Company, and the Washington-Virginia Railway Company, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to remove all poles and wires erected thereon belonging to each of said companies, located on King Street, from Harvard to Patrick Street, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and to replace such wires as are now located on said King Street on the poles to be erected thereon by the Virginia Public Service Corporation, upon such rentals, terms and conditions as shall be mutually satisfactory to each of said companies and the Virginia Public Service Corporation, or in case of joint ownership of such poles, as may be mutually satisfactory to the said Virginia Public Service Corporation and the Washington-Virginia Railway Company.

Section 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to in any way amend, alter, abridge, modify or change any rights, powers or privileges conferred upon the public utility companies herein mentioned under the franchise which they now possess, or the rights which they now enjoy under the laws of the State of Virginia.

Section 3. The said Virginia Public Service Corporation is hereby authorized to sell, and the Washington-Virginia Railway Company is authorized to buy such poles or any interest therein as may be necessary to the Washington-Virginia Railway Company, for the proper conduct of its business, upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually satisfactory to the said companies.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force from its passage.
