

ORDINANCE NO. 69

An Ordinance to permit the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company to remove its rails in Fayette Street, from the north side of Cameron Street to the south side of Duke Street.

Whereas, the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company desires to remove its rails in Fayette Street, from the north side of Cameron Street to the south side of Duke Street; and

Whereas, the said Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company has agreed to pay its share of the paving of Fayette Street, between King and Prince Streets, and to restore the other two squares between Cameron and King Streets and Prince and Duke Streets to the condition they are now in after removal of its rails; now therefore,

Section 1. Be It Ordained by the City Council of Alexandria, that the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company be and it is hereby authorized to remove its rails in Fayette, from the north side of Cameron Street to the south side of Duke Street, on the conditions above set forth.

Section 2. Be It Further Ordained that the removal of said rails from the above mentioned three squares shall not in any way affect or interfere with the ordinances heretofore passed by the City Council of Alexandria in regard to the use of the residue of Fayette Street by the said Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force from its passage.
