

ORDINANCE NO. 77

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Section 4 of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to grant to the Washington-Virginia Railway Company, its successors and assigns, the right or franchise to lay and maintain a single track of railway on Royal Street, from the south side of King Street to the south side of Franklin Street, with suitable curves, switches and connections to connect with the track now laid and operated by the Washington-Virginia Railway Company on King Street, and to erect, construct and maintain the necessary poles, fixtures and wires on, over, under and along the said street, and to run and operate over and upon the track to be so laid cars operated and propelled by electricity or other motive power than steam."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Section 4 of an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to grant to the Washington-Virginia Railway Company, its successors and assigns, the right or franchise to lay and maintain a single track of railway on Royal Street, from the south side of King Street to the south side of Franklin Street, with suitable curves, switches and connections to connect with the track now laid and operated by the Washington-Virginia Railway Company on King Street, and to erect, construct and maintain the necessary poles, fixtures and wires on, over, under and along the said street, and to run and operate over and upon the track to be so laid cars operated and propelled by electricity or other motive power than steam," reading:

"Section 4. That the said Washington-Virginia Railway Company, its successors and assigns, shall pay into the City Treasury for the privilege of using Royal Street, as aforesaid, the sum of sixteen hundred dollars per annum, from the first day of November, 1912, the said sum to be payable quarterly in advance," be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect June 1, 1928.
