

ORDINANCE NO. 81

An Ordinance to amend and re-enact Section 6 of Ordinance 64, approved the 19th day of May, 1927, and entitled "An Ordinance Imposing License Taxes on Persons, Firms, Companies, Associations, and Corporations Conducting Business or Engaging in Professional Employment Within the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and Providing for the Payment, Collection, Revocation and Regulation Thereof."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that Section 6 of Ordinance 64 be amended and re-enacted as follows:

"Section 6.—Automobiles. All motor vehicles, designed and used for the transportation of passengers shall be licensed for each calendar year, according to weight and for the purposes of this ordinance the weight of such vehicles shall be the same as that upon which the State license was computed and the amount of said license shall be twenty cents (20c) per one hundred pounds of weight, or major fraction thereof. Weight as defined by State law.

"Three-fourths of the said license fee required to be paid shall be collected whenever such license is issued on or after the 1st day of May in any year, and one-half of the license fee shall be collected whenever such license is issued on or after the 1st day of July in any year, and one-fourth of the license fee herein required to be paid shall be collected whenever such license is issued on or after the 1st day of October of any year.

"Licenses may be transferred from one car to another, or from one owner to another. All such transfers must be registered in the office of the City Collector.

"Each auto will be provided with a suitable tag which must be attached to the front of the car in such a manner as to be plainly visible at all times."

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
