

ORDINANCE NO. 83

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 80, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TIDEWATER OIL SALES CORPORATION OF NEW YORK, A CORPORATION EXISTING UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE, TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE PIPE LINES UNDER THE SURFACE AND ACROSS A PORTION OF NORTH FAIRFAX, NORTH ROYAL, WYTHE AND NORTH LEE STREETS, AND TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE A SIDE TRACK IN THE BED OF WYTHE STREET NEAR FAIRFAX STREET AND RUNNING INTO THEIR PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE SQUARE OF GROUND BOUNDED BY ROYAL, PITT, WYTHE AND MADISON STREETS, IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. That the Tidewater Oil Sales Corporation of New York, existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, be and is hereby authorized to construct, maintain, and operate three (3) pipe lines of a diameter of 8 inch, 6 inch and 4 inch, respectively, for the purpose of transporting petroleum or petroleum products beneath the surface of Fairfax, Wythe, Royal and Lee Streets, said pipe lines to cross Royal Street at right angles at a point approximately one-half way between Madison and Wythe Streets and diagonally across Wythe Street at the intersection of Fairfax Street and across Lee Street at right angles at about the south lot line of Wythe Street, originating on the property owned by the said Corporation and occupying the square of ground bounded by Royal, Pitt, Wythe and Madison Streets and running approximately 1,685 feet to a dock located near the channel of the Potomac River.

Said Tidewater Oil Sales Corporation shall install said pipe lines at least two (2) feet beneath surface of the street and in such manner as not to interfere with the use of said street by the public and shall maintain and keep said pipes and their contents in safe and proper condition and shall save the City of Alexandria harmless from any liability to persons using the said street by reason of the location of said pipes therein and shall also close as soon as practicable any excavations made for the purpose of installing or maintaining and shall restore the street to the condition in which it was before any of said excavations.

SECTION 2. The said Tidewater Oil Sales Corporation is hereby given authority to construct, operate and maintain a side track from a point on the Southern Railway track as now constructed on Wythe Street in a westwardly direction and crossing Royal Street at a point approximately the north building line of Wythe Street, and thence parallel to the said track of the Southern Railway on Wythe Street, and approximately forty (40) feet from existing track and across their property occupying the square of ground bounded by Royal, Pitt, Wythe and Madison Streets, and the said corporation shall maintain the said Wythe and Royal Streets between its tracks and on each side thereof within two (2) feet of said track in such manner and with such material as the adjoining part of said street is now maintained or shall be maintained, by the City of Alexandria, and shall save the City of Alexandria harmless from any liability to persons using the said street by reason of location of said side track.

SECTION 3. The said pipe lines and the said side tracks will be located in accordance with the drawing of the Tidewater Oil Sales Corporation, entitled, "Layout of Pipe Lines, Plant to Dock, Bulk Plant, Alexandria, Virginia," drawing No. 134-D-4, dated March 6th, 1929, under the caption of the Tidewater Oil Sales Corporation, 11 Broadway, New York City.

SECTION 4. The installation of said pipe lines and side tracks shall be under the supervision of the City Council or its legal representatives.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in effect from its passage.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall repeal in whole Ordinance No. 80, passed January 3, 1929.
