

ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LOAFING OR LOITERING ON THE STREETS, ALLEYS, OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Alexandria:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to habitually loiter or loaf on the streets, alleys, or other public places in the City of Alexandria, and when required so to do by any member of the police department, any such person or persons shall move on or separate.

2. Any person who shall be found guilty of loitering or loafing, as aforesaid, or who shall fail to move on or separate when required so to do, as aforesaid, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined for each offense not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.
