

## ORDINANCE 86

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SHELL-EASTERN PETROLEUM PRODUCTS, INCORPORATED, OF BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS, A CORPORATION EXISTING UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE, TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE PIPE LINES UNDER THE SURFACE AND ACROSS A PORTION OF MONTGOMERY, MADISON AND LEE STREETS, AND AUTHORIZING THE SHELL-EASTERN PETROLEUM PRODUCTS, INCORPORATED, AND THE SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY, TO MAINTAIN AND OPERATE A SIDE TRACK IN THE BED OF LEE STREET BETWEEN MADISON AND FIRST STREETS, AND RUNNING INTO THE PROPERTY OF SAID SHELL-EASTERN PETROLEUM PRODUCTS, INCORPORATED, LOCATED ON THE PLOT OF GROUND BOUNDED BY FAIRFAX, MADISON AND LEE STREETS, AND APPROXIMATELY HALF WAY BETWEEN FIRST AND MONTGOMERY STREETS, IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. That the Shell-Eastern Petroleum Products, Inc., of Boston, Massachusetts, a Corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, be, and it is hereby authorized to construct, maintain and operate five (5) pipe lines of a diameter of six (6) inches for the purpose of transporting petroleum, or petroleum products, beneath the surface of Lee, Madison, and Montgomery Streets, said pipe lines to cross at right angles to Montgomery Street and across Montgomery Street between Fairfax and Lee Street, and to cross Madison Street at right angles to Madison Street at some point between Fairfax and Lee Streets, and to run in an easterly direction, parallel to, and approximately ten (10) feet North of the South side of Madison Street across Lee Street, and at right angles to Lee Street, to the river and running approximately 1,000 feet to a dock located near the channel of the Potomac River.

Said Shell-Eastern Petroleum Products, Inc., shall install said pipe lines at least three (3) feet beneath the surface of the street and in such manner as not to interfere with the use of said street by the public and shall maintain and keep said pipes and their contents in safe and proper condition and shall save the City of Alexandria harmless from any liability to persons using the said streets by reason of the location of said pipes therein and shall also close as soon as practicable any excavations made for the purpose of installing or maintaining said pipe lines and shall restore the streets to the condition in which they were before any of said excavations.

Section 2. The said Shell-Eastern Petroleum Products, Incorporated, and the Southern Railway Company are hereby given authority to operate and maintain a side track from a point on the Southern Railway track as now constructed on Lee Street in a northerly direction and crossing Montgomery Street near Lee and thence parallel to the said track of the Southern Railway on Lee Street, and the said Shell-Eastern Petroleum Products, Incorporated, and the Southern Railway Company shall main-

tain the said Lee Street between its tracks and on each side thereof within two (2) feet of said track in such manner and with such material as the adjoining part of said street is now maintained or shall be maintained, by the City of Alexandria, and shall save the City of Alexandria harmless from any liability to persons using the said street by reason of location of said side track.

Section 3. The said pipe lines and the said side track will be located in accordance with the drawing of the Shell-Eastern Petroleum Products, Inc., entitled, "Proposed Terminal Facilities at Alexandria, Virginia," drawing No. D, dated October the 28th, 1929, under the caption of the Shell-Eastern Petroleum Products, Inc., Boston, Massachusetts.

Section 4. The installation of said pipe lines and side track shall be under the supervision of the City Council or its legal representatives.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in effect from its passage.
