

## ORDINANCE NO. 228

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931:**

**BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:**

SECTION 1. That the zoning map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931, be changed in the following particulars, to-wit:

That the following described property be changed from "C" Residential to "D" Commercial Zone:

BEGINNING at a point on the east side of Peyton Street at the Northwest corner of property now owned by W. W. Burroughs (which point is 128.39 feet, more or less, north of the intersection of Prince and Peyton Streets), thence along the north line of the Burroughs property eastwardly perpendicular to Peyton Street, 65 feet to the line of a ten foot alley leading from this point into Prince Street; thence South along said alley in a line perpendicular to Prince Street 43 feet 6 inches to a point on said alley 46 feet 6 inches from Prince Street; thence westwardly 90 feet, more or less, to Peyton Street; and thence northwardly along Peyton Street 55 feet to the point of beginning, with right of way over said ten foot alley leading from the rear of above described property to Prince Street.

That the area of Lots 148-176, both inclusive, and Lots 187-189, both inclusive, of the subdivision of Section 2, Brenton, being situated on the south side of Luray Avenue between Mount Vernon Avenue and Second Street, be changed from "A" Residential to "C" Residential zone.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
