

ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

SECTION 1. That the zoning map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931, be changed in the following particulars, to-wit: That the area of premises 901 North Columbus Street be changed from "A" Residential to "D" Commercial Zone.

That the area of Lot 5, Block 3, Map 210, which lot is located at the intersection of Mount Vernon and Mason Avenues, with a frontage on Mount Vernon Avenue of 273.46 feet and a frontage on Mason Avenue of 314 feet, which lot is now partly "D" Commercial, partly "C" Residential and partly "B" Residential, be changed to "D" Commercial in its entirety.

That the area of Lot 17 on the rear of lots 13, 14, 15, and 16, located on the south side of Monroe Avenue with a frontage of 50 feet extending eastward from a point 163.37 feet east of Mt. Vernon Avenue, be changed from "A" Residential to "D" Commercial Zone.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
