

ORDINANCE NO. 248

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 246 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved August 10th, 1937, and entitled: "AN ORDINANCE to provide a Board of Health for the City of Alexandria, prescribe the duties of said Board and to prescribe the method of appointment of City Health Officers and the employees of the Health Department."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 246 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved August 10th, 1937, be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 1. There is created a Board of Health for the City of Alexandria to be composed of seven members as follows: The Mayor, City Manager and City Attorney by reason of their offices, two members of the City Council to be appointed by the Mayor and two physicians practicing in the City of Alexandria to be appointed by the Council upon the recommendation of the Alexandria Medical Society and the physician members of the Board shall serve for terms of three years. Any vacancy occurring on the Board for the memberships filled by the members of the Council shall be filled by the Mayor and any vacancy occurring on the Board represented by the physician members shall be filled by the City Council upon recommendation of the Alexandria Medical Society."

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
