

ORDINANCE NO. 252

AN ORDINANCE to prohibit the use of saw-dust, wood-shavings, or similar materials for insulation purposes in any building erected in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. That the use of saw-dust, wood-shavings, or similar material for insulation purposes in the construction of any building in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100) and each day that such material is allowed to remain in any building in the City of Alexandria after notice from the City Manager to remove same, shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the day following its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
