

ORDINANCE NO. 276

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25, 1931.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the Zoning Map described and referred to in Section II of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, approved July 25, 1931, be and it hereby is amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

(a) That all that property known as 211 North Washington Street be changed from "A" Residence to "C" Residence Zone.

(b) That all that property known as Lot 3, Block 3, Map 133, being the west half of the lot measuring 90'x90' located at the southwest corner Montgomery and Washington Streets, be changed from "A" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

(c) That all that property known as Lots 20 to 26, inclusive, Block 1, located on the east side of North Alfred Streets between Wythe and Pendleton Streets be changed from "B" Residence to "C" Residence Zone.

(d) That all that property known as Lot 29, Block 6, Wilmar Park be changed from "A" Residence to "B" Residence Zone.

(e) That all that property known as 700 North St. Asaph Street be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

(f) That all that property situate at the southeast corner of Alfred and Gibbon Streets and belonging to J. R. and Margaret Virginia Harrison be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

(g) That all that property known as 938 North Columbus Street be changed from "A" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

(h) That all that property lying to the west of Powhatan Street and to the east of North Henry Street Extended and south of the Richmond, Fredericksburg & Potomac Railroad property now owned by West Bros. Brick Company be changed from "A" Residence to "C" Residence Zone.

(i) That the balance of the square bounded by Montgomery, First, Washington and St. Asaph Streets, being the south portion of said square and having a frontage of 38 feet on Washington Street and 100 feet on St. Asaph Street, be changed from "A" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

(j) That all that property known as 802 and 804 Madison Street and all that property known as Lots 11, 12, and 13 in the 700 Block of North Alfred Street Extended be changed from "B" Residence to "C" Residence Zone.

(k) That all that property known as Lot 2, Block 5, Map 106, located at Hunting Creek Road and South Street and belonging to Graham & Ogden, Inc. be changed from "A" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
