

## ORDINANCE NO. 287

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate and close as public streets all of that thoroughfare known as the old Georgetown Road lying north of Madison Street and south of Montgomery Street and lying north of Montgomery Street and South of First Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

WHEREAS, that thoroughfares known as the old Georgetown Road, in the City of Alexandria, traverses diagonally two certain squares of ground located in the City of Alexandria, which said squares are bounded by Patrick, Madison, Henry and Montgomery Streets and by Patrick, Montgomery, Henry and First Streets, respectively; and

WHEREAS, said thoroughfare has fallen into disuse so that the City of Alexandria and the public no longer require it as a public highway; and whereas, it appears equitable and just from the view points of the public and of the owners of property adjoining said thoroughfare to vacate and abandon the same;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That all of that thoroughfare known as the old Georgetown Road lying in the square bounded by Patrick, Madison, Henry and Montgomery Streets, and running from the north line of Madison Street to the south line of Montgomery Street, be and the same hereby is vacated and closed as a public street or thoroughfare.

Section 2. That this ordinance be recorded among the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approximately indexed in the name of the Council of the City of Alexandria and the street affected hereby.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
