

## ORDINANCE No. 327

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of South Street, Church Street and Lee Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA as follows:

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described portions of South Street, Church Street and Lee Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, have never been improved or used by the public as a thoroughfare or highway; and whereas, the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, desires not to assume the responsibility and expense of developing the hereinafter described portions of said streets; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed best for the welfare of the City and in the public interest that the hereinafter described portions of the said streets be vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portions of South Street, Church Street and Lee Street, all being situate within the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby are vacated:

- (a) All of South Street from a point equidistant between Royal Street and Fairfax Street running eastwardly to the Potomac River.
- (b) All of Church Street running from the East side of Lee Street to the Potomac River.
- (c) All of Lee Street from the South side of Church Street and running southwardly to Hunting Creek.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
