

## ORDINANCE NO. 329

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate First Street between Powhatan Street and the Mount Vernon Boulevard, including also a small portion of Columbus Street where it intersects with First Street, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:**

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described portions of First Street and Columbus Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia have never been improved or used by the public as a thoroughfare or highway; and whereas, the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia desires not to assume the responsibility and expense of developing the hereinafter described portions of said streets; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed best for the welfare of the City and in the public interest that the hereinafter described portions of the said streets be vacated;

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portions of First Street and Columbus Street, all being situate within the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby are vacated:

- (a) All of First Street between Powhatan Street and the Mount Vernon Boulevard.
- (b) That small portion of Columbus Street where it intersects with First Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
