

# ORDINANCE NO. 331

**AN ORDINANCE to amend the traffic laws of the City of Alexandria, Virginia by adding a paragraph to Section 29 of Chapter 11 of the Alexandria City Code and by repealing and re-enacting the first paragraph of Section 33 of Chapter 11 of the Alexandria City Code enacted July 2, 1940 and made effective August 5, 1940.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Section 29 of Chapter 11 of the Alexandria City Code be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph to the aforesaid section:

“(g) No motor vehicle shall be parked upon any portion of a public street or highway designated or used as a sidewalk or walkway area.”

Section 2. That the first paragraph of Section 33 of Chapter 11 of the Alexandria City Code be repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

“(1) It shall be unlawful for any person to steer, drive or operate any automobile or other motor vehicle, car, truck, engine, or train in the city while under the influence of alcohol, brandy, rum, whiskey, gin, wine, beer, lager beer, ale, porter, stout, or any other liquid, beverage or article containing alcohol or while under the influence of any narcotic drug, or any other self-administered intoxicant or drug of whatsoever nature.”

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
